1. A woman finds out she is pregnant. She is unsure how she can afford a baby.
2. She gets in contact with Bella House and she enters our Community Outreach Program. She joins a monthly parenting class about labor and delivery and she makes a new friend at the class.
3. The baby arrives and the mom now has all the baby essentials she needs such as diapers and a car seat, thanks to this program. It is a great relief and she starts to feel hopeful.
4. She attends the monthly parenting class with her baby and ends up winning a raffle item - a new crib. It is exactly what she needs as her baby has outgrown the bassinet. She goes home with baby clothes and more diapers.
5. Moms at the monthly parenting class start to build a network to help one another with babysitting. These moms no longer feel alone in this parenting journey.
6. With the help and encouragement of her case manager, the mom starts a new job with higher pay. Getting her GED was worth the extra effort. She opens a bank account to save a little each month while her baby continues to grow and begins preschool.
